"I would like to thank the jury one by one!" said Niliter Municipality Councillor Pelin Sevgi, who accepted the award. "We were competing against some very strong candidates, who put forward very impressive actions, so it's a great honour to receive this award." The Nillüfer city administration helped to organise award. The Niluter city administration helped to organise previously disorganised sections of civil society, ensuring they could participate in decision making through the establishment of neighbourhood committees (NCS). These NCs represent their neighbourhoods at city council level. Quotas were set to ensure that the NCs are also comprised of women, youth, disabled citizens and LGTBI residents.
